2018 Jeepers Jamboree - 3 Day Itinerary

** Check-in is **MANDATORY**. No trail access without a wristband **

Wednesday - July 25

9:00am - 6:00pm: Jeepers Jamboree Outdoor Expo on Main Street in Georgetown. The expo will have over 75 booths with truck and off-road accessories, camping gear and **Live music!**

Thursday - July 26

Noon - 8:00pm: Registration at the Jeepers Jamboree office on 6275 Main Street Georgetown, CA 95634. **Registration is mandatory.** Make sure to have your trip confirmation and copy of insurance with you for check in. All passengers need to sign a release of liability waiver in order to attend the event. Wristbands and vehicle stickers will not be handed out without signatures - **NO EXCEPTIONS**. Make sure you have a full tank of gas when you leave Georgetown.

10:00am - Midnight: Overnight Camping at Uncle Tom's Cabin - No Fee for camping. You can park tow vehicle and trailers at Uncle Tom's Cabin while on the trip but you will be charged a flat fee of \$30.00. No food available, bring your own food.

Friday - July 27

6:00am - 8:00am: Late registration at the Jeepers Jamboree office on 6275 Main Street Georgetown, CA 95634. **Registration is mandatory.** Make sure to have your trip confirmation and copy of insurance with you for check in. All passengers need to sign a release of liability waiver in order to attend the event. Wristbands and vehicle stickers will not be handed out without signatures - **NO EXCEPTIONS**. Make sure you have a full tank of gas when you leave Georgetown.

6:00am to 9:00am: Express Breakfast will be served at the Loon Lake Dam (Rubicon Trail head). Don't forget to grab your lunches on the right while going through the dam. Air down your tires and then hit the trail. You will see rock rollers throughout helping you conquer this famous trail.

Upon arrival to Rubicon Springs you will be greeted by one of our friendly volunteers who can direct you where to camp if you are unfamiliar with the area. Set up your tent and camp area, and then come to Main Camp for dinner and entertainment. The camp bar will be open before dinner

6:00pm - 8:00pm: Dinner in Rubicon Springs Bring your camp chair and your flashlight to main camp for the raffle held after dinner in front of the stage area. You must be present to win.

8:00pm - Midnight: Enjoy dancing to our live band. Enjoy classic beverages served by the American Legion at the no-host bar located at Amos Place next to the stage.

Saturday - July 28

7:30am - 9:00am: Breakfast in Rubicon Springs

9:00am - Historical talk in Rubicon Springs at the tented table area.

Noon - 1:30pm: Lunch in Rubicon Springs. Watch for entertainment after lunch.

6:00pm - 8:00pm: Dinner in Rubicon Springs. Don't forget to bring your camp chair and flashlight to Main Camp for the raffle after dinner located in front of the stage area. You must be present to win.

8:00pm - Midnight: Enjoy dancing to our live band. Enjoy classic beverages served by the American Legion at the no-host bar located at Amos Place next to the stage.

Sunday - July 29

6:00am - 7:00am: Express breakfast in Rubicon Springs for those who wish to get an early start. Rock rollers will be on the trail at 6am.

7:00am - 9:00am: Hot breakfast in Rubicon Springs

Please make sure you clean your camp area and pack everything out. There is a dumpster at the Tahoe staging area at the end of the trail. Please dump garbage in the dumpster, and the red mesh bags of recyclables in the trailer. There is also an air station to fill up your tires.

Lunch will be served at the top of Observation Point.

TOW VEHICLES

Tahoe Staging Area - No fee:

From Highway 50, turn north on Highway 89 towards Tahoe City. After about 16 miles from the famous "Y" at South Lake Tahoe, look for the McKinney Rubicon Road and turn left into the residential sub-division. Follow the signs to the Rubicon OHV Trail (it is a left, then a right and then curves left and right, then another hard left and then straight onto the paved part of the trail. Continue 1.5 miles to parking area.

Loon lake Staging Area - No fee:

You can get to Loon Lake by taking Wentworth Springs out of Georgetown or from Hwy 50 to Ice House Rd. Park at the bottom of Look Lake Dam also known as the trail head. Parking at Loon Lake fills up fast. Please do NOT park on the Dam or sides of the road or you will be ticketed

Uncle Tom's Cabin - \$30.00 flat fee

El Dorado County Fairgrounds - \$30.00 flat fee

Secured parking locked at night. Call (530) 621-5860 before coming through the gates so you can be directed on where to park

- Check fuel system along with hoses for cracks and leaks
- Check fan belts
- Check hoses
- Check power steering system components
- Check air filters
- Check SEAT BELTS
- Check tires for wear or damage
- Tighten drive shaft U-bolts
- Check and tighten lug bolts
- Check for CRACKS IN FRAME
- Check brake pads/shoes and related components
- Check for loose bolts and/or nuts throughout the vehicle
- Grease fittings
- Check gear oils: transfer case / differentials
- Check shocks and springs
- Double check winch and cable
